The fall agility trial will be held Friday, Sept 14th thru Sunday, Sept 16th on the Albert Drive kennel club grounds. (That is the same weekend as the conformation/ obedience show on the Expo grounds). Volunteers are needed in the following areas:

Thurs., Sept 13th: Building clean-up and grounds set-up takes place at the kennel club around 6 PM (under the direction of Burl Cavanaugh)

Fri., Sept 14th: Ring crew assignments. Volunteers should plan to be available on the property by 1 PM; the trial begins at 2 PM. We should conclude by 6 PM

Sat., Sept 15th & Sun., Sept 16th: Kitchen help, ring crew assignments, and clean-up at the conclusion on Sun. "Green" volunteers will be scheduled to work the Open and Novice level classes, which begin mid-day and conclude between 3 & 4 PM both days. "Seasoned" volunteers know "the drill!"
