There is a tremendous controversy about canine (and feline) vaccine protocols. Dr. Ronald Schultz has more than 45 years of experience in the field of immunology and has been a driving force behind many of the recent changes in vaccine recommendations made by the

American animal hospital association and other organizations.

This seminar will explain why, how, and which vaccines should be given to puppies and adult dogs. As importantly, Dr. Schultz will explain why his recommendations are correct based on his and other's research. This is a terrific seminar if you breed or own a dog, and or are a veterinarian or technician. This version of the seminar will be geared toward the informed dog owner, but is still detailed enough for veterinarians and vet techs.
